To Whom It May Concern:

In April we were asked to "Freeze" the Allegro Law accounts and get approval to process any incoming items. On 4/5/2010 an item for \$159.00 (from Vanco Services with description E.Service) was presented on 0200113207 and an item for \$1,770.00 (from Vanco Services with description E.Service) was presented on 0200113215. We requested approval to pay these items but we were informed that the approval would have to come from the court and they would notify us as soon as they received it. We only have 48 hours from the receipt of the ACH items to return them. On 4/7/2010 Louis Colley and Daniel Hamm appeared at the bank in person at approximately 4:30 p.m. They requested that all the pending items be returned. We attempted to return all of the pending items but our daily cutoff for processing ACH items is 4:00 p.m. so they did not process until the next business day making the two items mentioned above outside the return deadline and the next day the Federal Reserve charged these two items back us as a "dishonored return". Vanco Services was paid for these entries and River Bank & Trust has had to charge off the two items (totaling \$1,929.00) as losses and we would like to recover this loss.
