ORDER AUTHORIZING EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEY

Upon the application of the trustee seeking authority to employ Cunningham Bounds LLC, Attorneys at Law, to represent the estate herein (Doc. 16); and the court's being satisfied that it represents no interest adverse to the estate in the matters upon which it is to be engaged; that its employment is necessary and would be in the best interest of the estate; it is

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the court, while approving employment of the aforementioned attorneys, does hereby reserve its ruling on approval of the attorneys' fee as submitted.
